

Swanland LTC Covid 19 reopening Policy

These guidelines will be updated as guidance from the government & LTA changes as we are in constant contact with the LTA.

FACILITIES

The Clubhouse will remain closed until further notice.

The club will provide hand sanitizing gels for members and players to use before and after using the courts at the entrance to the club and each set of courts.

All the chairs, benches & will be removed for hygiene purposes

Net handles will be removed for hygiene purposes. The net height will be checked and adjusted regularly by T Arkut, please accept the net as you find it. Please try to touch the nets as little as possible.

TENNIS ACTIVITY

Activities are limited to Play and Coaching with no more than 2 people per Court except where 4 members of the same household play doubles. No mixed households more than 2 players per court.

No extra-curricular or social activity will take place until further notice

Social distancing rules should be observed at all times whilst on court

COURT ACCSESS

When you enter the club please leave the main entrance gate open so that other members entering do not have to touch the gate handles.

When you leave if there are other members still on site please leave the gate open, if you are the last member to exit please lock the gate as normal.

Please pay special attention to social distancing rules distance at pinch points such as the gates to courts and entry to the club.

The gate handles will be cleaned regularly each day.

EQUIPMENT

Players should bring their own equipment. We will not be lending out any rackets and balls until further notice.

COURT BOOKINGS

Play can only be allowed through a court booking system. Please book using the online booking system on clubspark. If you require access to the system please contact Simon Lee at swanlandltssecretary@gmail.com or on 07872 403880.

Courts will be available for sessions of 50 minutes starting on the hour and finishing at 10 to the next hour. Please ensure that you finish playing on time and leave the club in a timely manner so that the next members booked can access the court at their booked time with no cross over of members.

Bookings will only be taken for the next week at any time.

If you arrive before your booked timeslot please wait in the car park, ideally in your car for your time slot, instead of on the club grounds.

We understand this is a very rigid system, but this is required to comply with the LTA guidance on reopening.

If these rules are not followed unfortunately the committee will have to consider closing the club again if we feel that is not possible to offer a safe environment for all members

COACHING

Coaching will be done by Teo and Sam starting 13/05/2020

SPECTATORS

Spectators are not allowed on the courts or the club grounds. A parent or guardian (non-participant) of junior members or a carer for a disabled player are the only exceptions to this and only one spectator in such case is allowed on the club grounds only (not on the courts).

COMPETITIONS

There will be no competitions until further notice.
